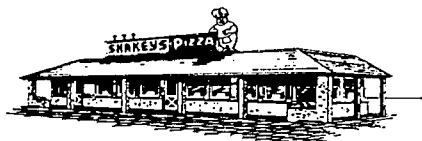
## JOHN P. POWERS

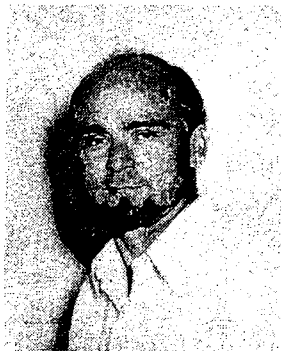
